Short biography:

Cristina (b. 1987) is a Romanian-Hungarian visual artist with a background in photography, who took a turn towards directing in 2007 while studying at the Faculty of Theatre & Television, Babes-Bolyai University in Cluj, Romania. She continued her studies with an MA at the Moholy-Nagy University of Art, Budapest, directing several shorts that travelled the worldwide festival circuit.

"Holiday at the Seaside" (2013) was regularly on Australian screens in cinema for one month, accompanying Andrea Arnold's *Fishtank*, but was also screened at festivals all around the world, picking up several prizes along the way (Sarajevo IFF, Helsinki IFF, London ISFF, Clermont-Ferrand ISFF, Mecal ISFF, Thessaloniki ISFF, Byron Bay IFF, Tangier ISFF, Tirana IFF, etc.). She is currently wrapping post-production for **"Work in Progress"**, a stylized comedy-drama set in a low-budget plastic surgery clinic in the middle of nowhere.

Cristina just received development funding for her first feature **"Things Worth Weeping For"**, which is being written with writer-actress Nora Rainer-Micsinyei.
